PURSUANT TO LOUISIANA REVISED STATUTE 44:35

NOW INTO COURT, through undersigned counsel, come Petitioner, JOHN E. SETTLE, JR., a resident of Caddo Parish, Louisiana, respectfully represents:

1.

That made Defendants herein is BOSSIER PARISH SCHOOL BOARD a governmental body located in Benton, Bossier Parish, Louisiana;

2.

The BOSSIER PARISH SCHOOL BOARD ("BPSB") is a "public body", as defined in Louisiana Revised Statutes 44:1(A)(1).

3.

That BPSB had three Bond issues submitted before the citizens of Bossier Parish, Louisiana for a vote on April 21, 2012.

4.

That the steps taken by BPSB in an attempt to pass the Bond issues is of significant importance to the Citizens of Bossier Parish, Louisiana.

5.

By letter dated April 27, 2012 (attached as Exhibit "A"), Petitioner, John E. Settle, Jr. forwarded a letter by telefax to the attention of Superintendent D.C. Machen of the BPSB requesting the following:

- "1. Contact information for all Bond attorneys BPSB/employees have consulted in re Bond issue;

2. Copies of all correspondence (letters emails) to and from Bond attorneys;”

6.

A second fax was forwarded dated April 27, 2012 (attached as Exhibit “B”) Petitioner John E. Settle, Jr. addressed to the attention of Superintendent D.C. Machen of the BPSB requesting the following:

- “1. All communications (emails & texts) to and from BPSB/employees to Clarence Babineaux in re Bond issue (construction, etc.)
2. All communications (emails & texts) from BPSB/employees to other BPSB employees in re Bond proposal/tax propositions
3. All press releases in re Bond proposal/tax propositions;”

7.

That to date Defendant has not provided the requested information set forth above.

8.

That Plaintiff has received a letter from Charles F. Hardie VI as general counsel on behalf of BPSB dated May 1, 2012, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit “C” to which Plaintiff responded by email dated May 2, 2012, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit “D”.

9.

That there have been no additional documents received to date and no responses to the email dated May 2, 2012. The Public Records Request has not been fully satisfied.

10.

Louisiana revised Statutes 44:35(B) provides that this Court has jurisdiction to enjoin the custodian from withholding records or to issue a writ of mandamus ordering the production of any records improperly withheld from the person seeking disclosure. The Court may view the sought after records in camera before reaching a decision.

11.

Louisiana Revised Statutes 44:35(C) provides that any suit brought to enforce the

provisions of the Public Records Law shall be tried by preference and in a summary manner.

12.

Louisiana Revised Statutes 44:35(D) provides that attorneys fees shall be awarded to the persons seeking public records, if such persons prevail.

13.

The public certainly has the right to know about any preparation made by BPSB in anticipation of the election of April 21, 2012.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner Prays that, after due proceedings had, Defendant be ordered to show cause why at a date and time to be fixed by this Honorable Court why a Writ of Mandamus ordering the production of such records should not be issued, as provided by Louisiana Revised Statutes 44:35; that all records requested by Petitioner be produced to this Court for the Court's in camera inspection, and for all costs, attorney's fees and other damages as provided by law.

FURTHER PRAYS for all orders and decrees necessary; for general and equitable relief.
