

ON 7/30/11 I OFC WHEATLEY #1227 RESPONDED TO 1234 TEXAS IN REGARDS TO AN ASSAULT & BATTERY. UPON ARRIVAL MADE CONTACT WITH B/F [REDACTED] WHO STATED SHE WAS ASSAULTED BY THE PASTOR/BOSS.

[REDACTED] STATED ON 7/11/11 HER BOSS/PASTOR CALLED HER TO HIS OFFICE AT 610 TEXAS TO RUN SOME ERRANDS. AROUND 6PM [REDACTED] STATED SHE THOUGHT IT WAS STRANGE TO BE AT HIS OFFICE DURING THAT TIME BECAUSE ALL THE LIGHTS WERE OFF AND NO ONE WAS THERE BUT JACKSON.

HOLDEN THEN STATED ONCE SHE WALKED IN THE OFFICE JACKSON LOCKED THE DOOR. SHE STATED HE THEN STARTED ASKING HER QUESTIONS ABOUT HER BEING A VIRGIN [REDACTED] STATED THEN JACKSON TOLD HER TO CALL ANOTHER B/F WHO RECENTLY JUST STARTED GOING TO THEIR CHURCH TO COME TO THE OFFICE BECAUSE HE WANTED TO LEARN TRICKS ON HOW TO LICK ON HER "PEARL TONGUE."

[REDACTED] STATED JACKSON THEN STARTED TO LICK HIS TONGUE OUT AND MOVE IT UP AND DOWN, STATED JACKSON INSISTED ON HER DOING IT BUT SHE TOLD HIM NO. [REDACTED] STATED SHE THEN WENT TO LEAVE THE OFFICE AND JACKSON TOLD HER TO SIT DOWN & AFTER SHE DIDN'T JACKSON GRABBED BOTH ARMS AND PUSHED HER AGAINST THE WALL AND STARTED TO KISS HER, PUTTING HIS TONGUE IN THE MOUTH ALSO HE WAS RUBBING HER REAR END. HOLDEN STATED SHE TOLD JACKSON TO STOP, AND WHEN HE DID HE TOLD HER IF SHE TOLD ANYONE HE WOULD "KILL HER." HOLDEN STATED SHE LEFT THE OFFICE TERRIFIED.

HOLDEN STATED SHE CONTACTED JACKSON ON 7/29/11 TO GET PER PAYCHECK AND JACKSON STARTED SENDING TEXTING HER PHONE. ONE TEXT JACKSON SENT ON 7/29/11 AT 1230 PM "HOW MUCH YOU CHARGE FOR ANOTHER LESSON ON THAT PEARL." [REDACTED] STATED HE KNEW THEN SHE HAD TO TELL SOMEONE BEFORE SHE ENDED UP HURT. HOLDEN ALSO STATED THE REASON SHE DIDN'T REPORT THE INCIDENT SOONER BECAUSE SHE WAS "SCARED HE" WOULD CARRY OUT HIS THREAT [REDACTED] WAS ADVISED TO STOP ALL COMMUNICATIONS WITH JACKSON AND KEEP ALL TEXT MESSAGES.

OFFICERS DID NOT MAKE CONTACT WITH JACKSON. THE REPORT WAS FILED AND SENT TO THE DETECTIVE'S OFFICE. HOLDEN STATED SHE HAVE BEEN WORKING FOR JACKSON SINCE JUNE.

lights were off, it was dark. She went up to his office and knocked on the door and he let her in. When she walked in, he turns around and locks the door and told her to sit down. He told her daughter that her work for today was to show him how to lick that pear. Her daughter told him that she do not do that. He told her to call one of her gay friends up here so they could show him some tricks. He put his hand to his mouth and started licking his tongue up and down and told her to do the same. She stated that she did do the same thing thinking that it would end this ordeal.

He then got up from his desk and walked over to her. He grabs her by the arms, pulls her up and started kissing her. He was putting his tongue in her mouth and grabbing her butt. She finally pushed him away and he told her to sit down. He looked at her and told her that if she tells anyone, he will kill her. He unlocks the door to his office and she left the building. When she got into her truck to leave, she texts the pastor and told him that this was wrong and it will never happen again. After hearing this, she was in Dallas and she told her brother to bring her home. When she got home her daughter told her what had happen again. When her daughter finished talking, she called a deacon and told him that she needs to talk to him.

On Saturday, July 30, 2011, three of the church deacons came to talk to her. She had her daughter to tell them what happen between her and the pastor. When she had finished, the deacon told her that they will take it from here. She received another call from a deacon and he told her that they had a meeting with Pastor Jackson on Sunday, July 31, 2011 and he was told of the allegation. After the meeting, Pastor Jackson did call her on Monday, August 1, 2011. He told her that her daughter put her tongue on his lip and he did kiss her on her mouth. On the following day, Monday, August 1, 2011, the deacon had a meeting at 6 pm. They decided to wait until the criminal investigation is over before they take any action. The deacon told her because of previous incident, he had been warned.

She gave this officer two deacons name, Willie Jones Jr. and Linnon Warren and advised they might have some information on this situation and some history on thing in the past. I called both individual and set up an interview time with them. On August 5, 2011 at 1156 hours Mr. Willie Jones Jr. came to Youth Service Unit to give an interview. He is a black male who lives at 9278 Stratmore Drive and is driver license number is 003167590. He was first made aware of the allegation on Sunday, July 31, 2011, when he attended church at the Mount Olive Baptist Church. They had a special call meeting on Monday, August 1, 2011, with the twelve deacons to discuss the allegation with the pastor but this was never done. After everyone had left the Chairman and three other deacons went in an talk with the pastor in reference to the allegation. They advised that the pastor denied everything.

On Monday, August 1, 2011, he and his wife went over to the [REDACTED]'s residence. He advised that [REDACTED] daughter told him what happen between her and Pastor Jackson. He advised that when the child was telling him what had happen, she was shaking and scared to tell her story. Mr. Jones advised that he believed what the young girl was telling him. Mr.

Jones advised that she is one of the nicest, well manner young ladies that you will want to meet.

On August 5, 2011 at approximate 1300 hours Mr. Linnon Warren who is the Administrator of the church came to the Youth Service Unit to give an interview. He is a black male, DOB: 2/25/1935, telephone (cell) 455-5396 and he live at 2819 Brownlee Road in Bossier City, Louisiana. On Saturday, July 30, 2011, he received a telephone call from [REDACTED] and she invited him to her home to discuss a matter involving her daughter and the pastor. He along with the Chairman of Deacon Board and another deacon responded to [REDACTED] residence. Upon their arrival, [REDACTED] advised them at her daughter wanted to tell them what happen between her and Pastor Jackson.

[REDACTED] daughter [REDACTED], told them while she was at work for Pastor Jackson at Southern University of Shreveport Metro Campus, 610 Texas, and Pastor Jackson attack her physically. Pastor Jackson held her against her will and he was kissing her. She was finally able to get away from Pastor Jackson and he told her that if she tells anyone, he, Pastor Jackson, would kill her. She went to her cellphone and showed them several text messages from Pastor Jackson to her. One of the text messages, Pastor Jackson "asks her what will it cost him to lick her pearl." Another one of the text messages is where he was asking her to meet him at Nicky's for some drinks. When she told him that she was not old enough to drink that is when he told her that he was just playing.

Mr. Warren advised that on the next day, Sunday July 31, 2011, four deacons meet with Pastor Jackson in his office. They told him about the allegation that [REDACTED] had made against him and he denied it. Pastor Jackson advised that he did not threaten to kill her if she tells anything. Pastor Jackson goes on to states that the text message about the Pearl was only a joke. He advised that if you look at the end of the text there is a smiley face. He called a meeting with the twelve deacons and they were advised of the allegation against the pastor. They decided to hold off of making a decision on the pastor until the criminal part has been decided.

Mr. Warren advised that he is the administrator of the church and he is stuck in the middle, not leaning either way. He has been knowing the [REDACTED] all of his life, in fact, they are kin to him. He has never known the young lady to lie or make up a story about anyone; she is a nice person. He also loyal to the pastor until it is proving that he did something wrong.

A lot of members are asking for the pastor resignation because of some thing that have happen in the past. He has been arrested for DUI with another women in his vehicle that was not his wife. There are also a lot of rumors about the pastor and woman but nothing has been proving.

On August 8, 2011 at approx. 1620 hours, I tried to make contact with Mr. Jackson and received no answer when I called his office. I then left him a detail message with my number for him to call this officer.

He text her later and told her that he could have taken the drink. He then asked her how she would feel if they would go out for drinks. She told him no because he was her Pastor and he had a wife.

They continue to text each and one day he looked on her face book page and learned that she had a boyfriend. He told her that now that you got a new nigger why you do not come to church. He acts like he was jealous of her new boyfriend. He continue to make little sly comment and she finally told him off in text message and when she did that he quit texting and calling her. She advised they did not do anything together, they only text and talk on the telephone. 



AFFIDAVIT FOR ARREST WARRANT

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Detective Dennis Pratt, a Shreveport Police Officer for 25 years who, being first duly sworn, deposed and said that on or about 07/11/11, in Caddo Parish, Louisiana, One Theron Jackson committed the offense of Simple Battery in that He violated Louisiana R.S. 14:35 in that He intentionally use force or violence upon a person of another without the consent of the victim contrary to the law of the State of Louisiana and against the peace and dignity of the same.

CAUSE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A WARRANT HEREIN IS AS FOLLOWS:

At approximately 1518 hours the interview with the victim, [REDACTED] was conducted in the Juvenile Interview Room. She is a black female [REDACTED] and she live at [REDACTED] in Shreveport, Louisiana. She advised that when she lost her job, her pastor Theron Jackson offered her a job. He told her that he needs someone to run errands for him and to do some light typing. She advised every day she had to call him to see if there was something for her to do. On July 11, 2011 she had called earlier that morning and was told not to come in. Later on in that day her boss and pastor called her and told her to come to work. He told her to come after (5) five pm and before (6) six pm. She called her mother and told her that she had to go to work. When she arrived at Southern University Metro Campus, 610 Texas, she parked in the student lot in the back of the campus. When she got to the building all of the lights were off and the doors were open. She took the elevator to the fourth floor and knock on the door. When she walked into his office, he immediately locked the door and told her to sit down. He told her that her lesson for today is to teach him how to lick it, the pearl. She told him that she was a virgin and she does not know what he was talking about. He told her to call one of her gay friend and they both could show him some tricks. Pastor Jackson got up from behind his desk, walked over to her and grabs her by the arms. He pushes her to the wall and started kissing her, putting his tongue in her mouth and rubbing on her butt. She was pushing on him and telling him to stop. He finally stopped and told her to sit down. When she had sat down, he looked her in her eyes and told her that if she tells anyone, he will kill her. He unlocked the door and she left the building. She walked back to her vehicle and while sitting in her vehicle, she text him. She told him that this was not right and it will never happen again. He sent her a text back asking her how much she would charge for him to lick her pearl. She drove home upset and when she arrived home, all she told her mother was that, that man was crazy and she did not want to get him in trouble. He presided over one of her cousin wedding and while at the reception he was offer a drink and he refused. He text her later and told her that he should have taken the drink. He then asked her how she would feel if they would go out for drinks. She told him no because he was her Pastor and he had a wife.

They continue to text each and one day he looked on her face book page and learned that she had a boyfriend. He told her that now that you got a new nigger why you do not come to church. He acts like he was jealous of her new boyfriend. He continue to make little sly comment and she finally told him off in text message and when she did that he quit texting and calling her. She advised they did not do anything together, they only text and talk on the telephone. She advised that Pastor Jackson is supposed to have a child by one of the church member, Brandy Gardner (Norman). She advised that she was working at LSUMC.

On August 8, 2011 at approx. 1620 hours, I tried to make contact with Mr. Jackson and received no answer when I called his office. I then left him a detail message with my number for him to call this officer. On August 10, 2011 at approx. 1318 hours I call Mr. Jackson at his office again and I was told that he was not at work today. I then called his cell phone and he did not answer. I left him a message telling him that I needed to talk to him in reference to the allegation that was made against him. On August 12, 2011 at approx. 1545 hours, this officer called attorney Shanta Wells (318) 349-1441, who had called earlier in reference to Mr. Jackson. The allegation against Mr. Jackson was explained to him. He advised Mr. Jackson was out of town but he should return this weekend. Mr. Wells advised that he would talk with Mr. Jackson and call me by Monday. I then advised him that the case will be forwarded to the District Attorney's office for review even if Mr. Jackson is not interviewed.

While there is a lot of inappropriate behavior toward the female victim, Mr. Jackson is only been charged with simple battery because he grab and kiss the victim without her consent. The victim's statement is also consistent with the text messages that are on the cellphone and the witnesses' statement.

Wherefore: Affiant prays that a warrant be issue herein for the arrest of said accused that He may be dealt with according to the law.
